Bloodborne Pathogens (Healthcare) – 60 mins

Covers OSHA requirements for bloodborne pathogens, including routes of exposure; risks associated with HIV, Hepatitis B, and Hepatitis C; methods for preventing pathogen transmission and managing occupational exposures; safe sharps disposal; and what to do after a potential exposure.



Health Insurance Portability & Accountability Act (HIPAA) – 40 mins

Provides an overview of the privacy rule, including who is covered, what information is protected, general rules for uses and disclosures, how to identify violations, and penalties for noncompliance.



Safe Patient Handling – 30 mins

Covers OSHA requirements for bloodborne pathogens, including routes of exposure; risks associated with HIV, Hepatitis B, and Hepatitis C; methods for preventing pathogen transmission and managing occupational exposures; safe sharps disposal; and what to do after a potential exposure.



Biological Agents and Infection Control – 60 mins

Defines healthcare-associated infections and microorganisms and covers chain of infection, controlling spread through safe handling of potentially contaminated equipment or surfaces, and recognizing the importance of hand hygiene, respiratory hygiene, and cough etiquette.
